

NJ Educators Health Plan & Garden State Plan Mandatory Generics

Pursuant to the Chapter 44 requirements, the NJ Educators Health Plan and Garden State Plan include the addition of the Mandatory Generics.

Mandatory Generics is the practice of requiring members to fill a generic medication in place of a brand when available. Generic alternatives have the same chemical makeup and same effect in the body as their original brand-name counterparts. Though generics may have a different name, color, and/or shape, generics have undergone rigorous clinical testing and been approved by the U.S. Food & Drug Administration (FDA) as safe and effective.

Members must fill generic medications when available or incur a penalty. The penalty cost to fill a brand medication when a generic equivalent is available is the difference in cost between the generic drug and brand drug, plus the brand copay.

Express Scripts, the Prescription Benefit Manager for the SHIF, has provided the below list of the most commonly prescribed brand drugs with generic equivalents available. This list is comprised of actual medications filled by Schools Health Insurance Fund members but is listed for illustrative purposes only as drug costs and status on a drug formulary can be subject to change over time.

If there is a clinical need for a patient to fill the branded version of the medication, the prescribing provider, may contact Express Scripts at, 1-800-753-2851 to request a clinical authorization review. If the clinical review approves, the brand penalty will not apply.

It is important to note additional drugs are impacted and cost estimates will change when additional generic alternatives of brand name drugs become available during the year.
